Change in Tariffs for Tour Bus Parking in Gmunden

On July 3, 2025, the city council of Gmunden introduced an additional bus parking tariff of €25 for a maximum of 3 hours, which will be valid from July 10, 2025, at the bus parking areas Toscana, Weyer, and Seebahnhof. The daily tariff of €50 per bus has been in effect since May 1, 2025, at the bus parking areas Toscana and Weyer.

To somewhat cushion the new costs for bus operators and their guests, the Traunsee-Almtal Tourism Association will provide a budget of €5,000 and offer bus operators a cost replacement as follows:

- Bus stays up to 3 hours = €25 tariff (€8.33 per hour). No refund.
- 4 hours = €50 daily tariff, of which the bus receives €16.65 refunded.
- 5 hours = €50 daily tariff, of which the bus receives €8.34 refunded.
- From 6 hours onwards, the daily tariff of €50 applies. No further refund.

This offer is only valid in conjunction with booking a service with Traunsee Shipping, Grünberg Cable Car, Treetop Walkway, Stern & Hafferl Transport, Seeschloss entrance + castle or city tour.



Handling:

The bus operator/driver buys a day ticket at the ticket machine (Toscana parking lot, Weyer, and in the future also Seebahnhof). Upon departure, they take a photo of the ticket machine (showing the time). The photographed day ticket + photo of the ticket machine + company and bank details should be emailed to reisebuero@traunsee-almtal.at, and the refund will be processed within a few days.

This offer will also be communicated through our partner companies and local attractions (Traunsee Shipping, Stern & Hafferl, Grünberg Cable Car, Treetop Walkway), the city administration of Gmunden, the Chamber of Commerce, and via direct mailing to bus operators from our address database as well as on our website.
