## Discover and Experience the Treetop Walk

With a total length of 1,400 meters (including the ramp in the view tower) and a height of up to 21 meters, the treetop walk winds its way through the mixed mountain forest on the summit of the Grünberg (1,004 meters above sea level), passing numerous learning and activity stations.

## Wheelchair Friendly

With a maximum gradient of 6 %, the treetop walk and tower can be accessed by wheelchairs and prams alike. The railing's net-type construction provides an unobscured view of the surroundings. Wheelchairs and wheeled walkers can be borrowed free of charge at the entrance.

## Please Note

Bicycles, scooters etc. are not permitted on the treetop walk.

## View Tower

The highlight of the walkway is the 39 meter high, architecturally unique view tower. The tower's highest platform provides an impressive view of the whole alpine upland and the Salzkammergut, from the Traunsee to the Dachstein. The 55-meter tunnel slide, inside the tower, is great fun for anyone 6 years of age and over.

## Duration of Stay & Admittance

For a visit to the treetop walk, we recommend you plan for about 1.5 hours. You can purchase tickets at the ticket office and start the walk until 1 hour before closing.

## Dogs & Pets

Dogs (and animals of all kinds) are not permitted on the treetop walk. There are boxes with drinking water available.

## Dining

The Grünbergalm is located right next to the treetop walk and offers a high-quality, classic Austrian menu. If you take a walk to the Laudachsee, the Ramsaualm awaits you with its special ambience and culinary delights.

## Grünberg Cable Car

The Grünberg has been accessible by cable car since 1957. Since the original cable car was replaced in 2014, the two large, accessible cabins carry up to 60 people.
