


Hours of operation: July until beginning of September every Sunday.



Town Hall — The town hall is located on the "Townhall Square" and houses the ceramics chime, which was crafted in the unique "flowery green" style by the world-famous china-manufacturer "Meißen".



Parish Church – The most valuable component of the parish church is the high altar created by Thomas Schwanthaler (the only Three Kings altar in Austria). The Virgin of Mercy made of ceramics, which is located above the right side entrance to the church is known as an appreciation symbol for the preservation of damages in Gmunden during WWII.



Salt-Bearer-Well -

The well is located on the "Rinnholzplatz" and it is the only well in Austria made of ceramics.

It depicts the profession "salt-bearer".
